

Maryland Fraternities Cite First Amendment Rights in Petitioning Federal Judge to Reinstate Operations

Alfred Carry in McGlinchey's Washington, DC office was quoted in a March 13, 2024 article in *The Baltimore Sun*. The piece details situation at the University of Maryland College Park, where a number of fraternities and sororities seek to reinstate operations while a University investigation proceeds.

"That members of these chapters may not speak to one another about what the University is doing is clearly an infringement upon First Amendment freedoms of speech," attorneys Alfred Dumetz Carry from Washington D.C.-based firm McGlinchey Stafford and Micah Kamrass from Cincinnati-based firm Manley Burke Burke wrote in the petition.
