In a testament to the organization's work, they were recipients of a [\\$5 million grant from the Mackenzie Scott Foundation](#) in 2020.

"McGlinchey is strongly committed to supporting the communities where we live and work, and Amanda's leadership with United Way exemplifies those values," said **Michael Ferachi**, the firm's Managing Member, also based in Baton Rouge. "The Capital Area United Way plays a critical role in supporting our fellow community members, and Amanda is well suited to lead their efforts."

Amanda has served on the United Way board of directors since 2012, including as Community Impact Cabinet Chair, Secretary, and Chair-Elect. She is very active in the Louisiana State and Baton Rouge Bar Associations, Federal Bar Association, as well as First United Methodist Church.
