Aaron Kouhought (Cleveland) will co-present on a panel titled "As Technology Advances, Privacy Litigation Trends Continue to Morph."

Kelly Lipinski (Cleveland) will speak on "Student Loan Hot Topics," including developments in state law regulation of the private education lending industry, with a focus on the increased regulation and supervision of student loan servicers, and developments relating to the dischargeability of student loans given recent litigation trends and guidance from the CFPB.
