

Will two newer credit scores beat a single older one for mortgages?

Member **Jim Milano** (Washington, DC) was quoted in a *National Mortgage News* article on the Federal Housing Finance Agency's plan to replace the FICO Classic credit score used by government-sponsored enterprises with two new ones by 2025.
